SEARCH

- Most common search by name and DOB
- Ethnicity
 - Like having the option
 - Not used to search by itself
- SMATs and SMAT Description
 - Like having the option, may be useful
 - Not used to search by itself
- SSN
 - Include on screen for searching
 - Help to narrow search
 - Need to check on limited use of SSN as an identifier

SEARCH RESULTS

- Display agency who data belongs to
 - Both "yes" and "no" response to this
 - Yes – need to know which agency's data to "select" when entering juvenile for the first time
- Multiple names should display
- Good to know there is existence of a photo; use a camera icon
- Photos are helpful when multiple names exist

JUVENILE HISTORY

- Ability to know that data exists that is not viewable
- Display different Agency IDs
- Demographics: use of "Current Age:"
- Parents & associates
 - Include phone and address info
 - More info is better, i.e. helpful
- Juvenile Address: remove Address Type since "Business" is not used
- Offense Info
 - Provide searchable fields: Arrest Date, Report Number, Disposition
 - Ability to display specific type of offense info, e.g. pending, convictions, particular agency
 - Display arrest and final information
 - Offense Section (HRS) may display in details

LETTERS OF APPREHENSION (LOA)

- Include Weed & Seed Letter that is open-ended
- "Highlight" that there is an active LOA, i.e. at top of the Juvenile History in red
- Distinguish the different types of letters; LOA is sometimes mistaken for Letter Of Apology

DIVERSIONS

- Include programs from OYS
