SEARCH

- Ability to search on Alias type
- Ability to search for specific Middle Name
- Question: How does one search on names with multiples names and/or hyphens?
 - Recommend use of Sounds Like option using "*[name]*", e.g. if name is Janet-Shana or Shana-Janet use "*Shana*" or "*Janet*"

SEARCH RESULTS

- Question: What will be the result if both name criteria and ID are entered?
- If only displaying a single line on the Search Results screen, display the legal name if it exists (from FC)
- If no legal name exists, display the most recent name provided

DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION

- \circ $\;$ Ability to capture and distinguish Residence vs. Mailing address $\;$
- Ability to cross-check address with who they're living with, e.g. living with foster parent but may give residential address of aunt

JUVENILE HISTORY

 Would like to see Probation information with Earned/Unearned; for example could it display on Offense Info between DISPO and DATE (Note: a further explanation by Lana Paiva clarified that this requires the FC JUSTIS system to be modified. Then this information could be sent and displayed in the NG JJIS).

- Question: Would it be beneficial for agency systems to send Notes? Could it capture the reason why something was Withdrawn?
- Ability to filter on Missing/Wanted Information
- Display "Open" items, e.g. WAR, at top and easily seen
- If juvenile has "Open" items, would like to see them on the Search Results screen in Red and easily seen, e.g. have it flashing

GENERAL

- How do agency users bring request items to the JJIC if there is information that they would like to see in the JJIS?
- For Agency abbreviation, could it display consistently among the different types?
 Use of 3PD, 3PA and 3FC rather than HCPD, HCPA and FC.
