Today's discussion covered: Presentation of Juvenile Search, Juvenile History and Missing/Wanted screens. The following was suggested.

**SCREENS:**

JJIS Search screen:

1. Question on whether name search will search Alias too. Yes it will search last, first middle and alias names.

JJIS History screen:

1. Investigate whether to add name of Judges.
2. Requested ability to click on the report number and get more details on that police report. Follow up on getting the scanned image of the police reports.
3. Maui approves of separating the Missing/Wanted and Warrants into two sections.
4. Requested the information from the search screen block to show on the top of the history screen.
5. In Legal Status block, display current probation officer
6. Investigate showing special conditions in Legal Status block.

ADDM/W screen:

1. There is a need to access photos from closed cases.
2. Requested ability to click on the report number and get more details on that police report.
3. NCIC cannot accept '.'s. Need to automatically change periods to semicolons.
4. Make School field mandatory
5. Make DOB field mandatory
6. Make Runaway Date field mandatory if type is "Runaway".
7. Maui is okay with adding the Officer's name who closed the case.
8. Change Abductor scroll bar to include Name (concatenated Last, First, Middle), Alias and Relationship only.
9. Affirmed that they would like the AGE to be automatically calculated from DOB entered.
10. Multiple vehicles will be added in the Notes section; no scroll bar necessary.
11. Add "Type" field to Vehicle Tab (2 door, 4 door, etc.)

Other: What happens to the information for the juvenile when they turn 18?

Answer- Information is archived according to rules established by the Hawaii Supreme Court.
