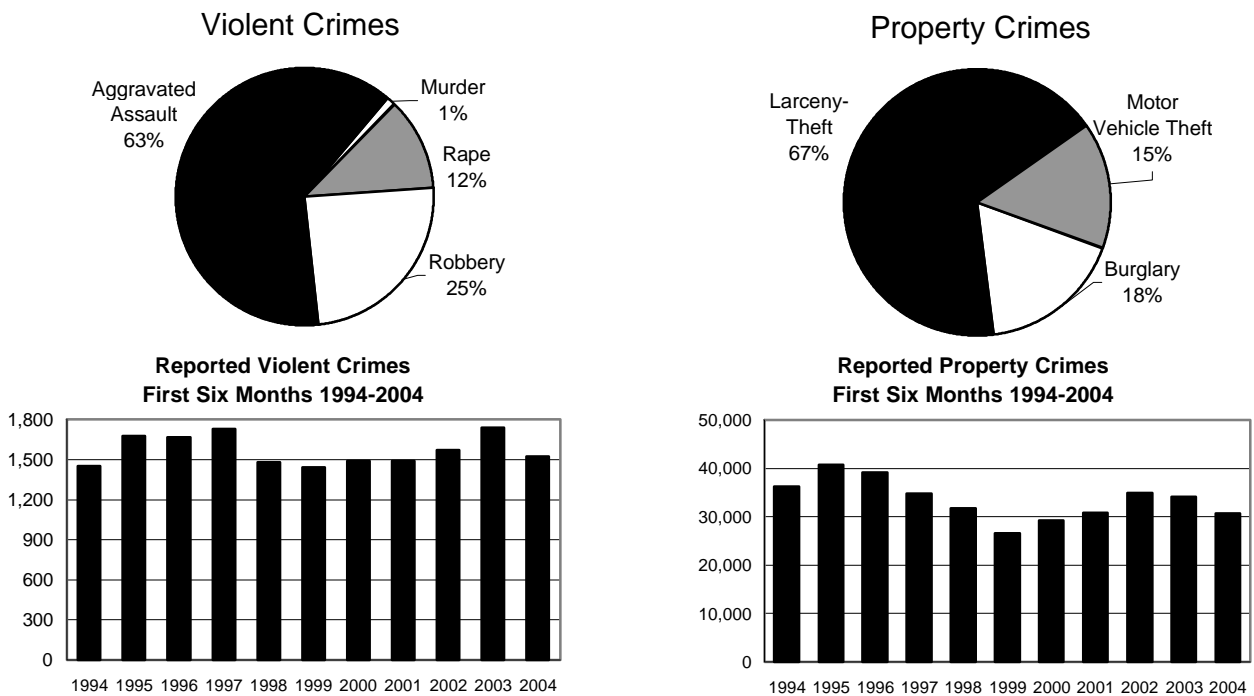

Data derived from arrests and crimes reported to the police can only provide estimates of the actual extent of crime. Shifts in law enforcement focus, isolated cases resulting in multiple arrests, and broader societal changes that affect the likelihood that victims will report certain types of crimes are some of the factors that may affect these data.

The number of Index Crimes¹ reported in Hawaii during the first six months of 2004 decreased 10.2% from the number reported during the same period in 2003. The number of reported violent crimes (murder, forcible rape, robbery, and aggravated assault) decreased 12.6%, and the number of reported property crimes (burglary, larceny-theft, and motor vehicle theft) fell 10.1%.

All four counties reported decreases in total Index Crimes, violent crimes, and property crimes during the first six months of 2004 as compared to the first half of 2003. The City & County of Honolulu's tallies decreased 9.3%, 12.8%, and 9.1%, respectively. Hawaii County reported 16.9%, 15.4%, and 16.9% decreases. Maui County's decreases totaled 11.2%, 9.4%, and 11.2%. Kauai County posted 7.1%, 12.1%, and 6.7% decreases. The proportion of Index Crimes cleared by arrest or exceptional means (11.0%) decreased by 0.6 percentage points.

Statewide juvenile and adult arrests for Index Crimes decreased 3.5% and 17.3%, respectively, during the first half of 2004. Juvenile arrests decreased 8.9% for Part II offenses, with a corresponding 7.8% increase for adults. Kauai County reported the greatest decrease in overall arrests (10.7%), while the City & County of Honolulu posted the only increase (5.7%).

The value of property stolen in Hawaii during the first half of 2004 totaled \$30.5 million, an increase of 3.8% from the same period in 2003.
