The following is a list of the reporting requirements that came out of the needs assessment phase of the NG JJIS project. These are the reports that the line people have asked for to help them in their operational tasks. I am sure that as reporting gets discussed at the user level and administrator level more reporting requirements will be developed. None of the reports listed were part of the Mission Critical requirements. Most came out of the Desired category. The brief description of the report is followed by the requirement number in parentheses. Some of the descriptions are broad and need to be narrowed by the Research subcommittee or more clearly defined by the member-agency that requested the report. One of the operational requirements for the reporting is to be able to change variables such as date range, offense, severity, etc. Let me know if you have any questions.
