A statement received after June 6, 2014, will be considered a "late submittal" for the balance of the fiscal year as follows:

September 6, 2014 - December 5, 2014

December 6, 2014 – March 6, **2015**

Will be considered beginning:

October 1, 2014

January 1, 2015

April 1, 2015
