Attorneys will be considered for contract under Hawaii Revised Statutes §103D-304, as the need arises.

A new statement must be submitted pursuant to this Notice, even if you submitted a statement in the past. **Attorneys from the same firm must submit separate statements.**

In the past, we have contracted for legal services in the following areas. Attorneys may list other areas of practice **but are limited to no more than three areas.**

Your completed statements must be postmarked or received by the State Department of the Attorney General by Friday, June 1, 2012 to be eligible for consideration for the entire fiscal year commencing July 1, 2012 and ending June 30, 2013.

A statement received after June 1, 2012, will be considered a "late submittal" for the balance of the fiscal year as follows:
