#### **State ID Cards For Molokai**

Honolulu, Hawaii - Attorney General Earl I. Anzai announced today that residents of Molokai would be able to obtain State ID cards on-island. Once again State personnel will be on the Island of Molokai on Saturday, May 4, 2002, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., at the Mitchell Pauole Center to provide this service.

First priority will be given to individuals with completed applications and required certified documents. Those individuals may make an appointment through Ms. Beverly Pauole-Moore, Governor's Liaison Officer at 553-1752. The fee is \$10.00 for senior citizens 65 years and older, and \$15.00 for all others, payable in cash only. The State ID cards will be processed and mailed back to the applicant within 5-10 working days.
