Arrests Made in Airport "Kickback" Investigation

Attorney General Earl I. Anzai announced today that the Department of the Attorney General arrested Dennis Hirokawa, maintenance superintendent for the Honolulu International Airport on charges of Theft in the First Degree and Bribery. Also arrested was Antonio Bio, airfield and grounds maintenance supervisor, who was arrested on the charge of theft in the second degree. Both men were arrested at the Honolulu International Airport, transported to District Court receiving desk for booking and released pending further investigation. The arrest took place in conjunction with the on-going investigation into forgery, theft and bribery related to small purchase contracts awarded at the Honolulu International Airport.
