MOTHER OF FIVE SENT TO JAIL FOR FIVE YEARS

Acting Attorney General Thomas R. Keller announced today that First Circuit Court Judge Michael A. Town revoked Laurie Anne K. Apolo's probation and sentenced her to 5 years of incarceration.

Apolo, age 24, was on probation for two counts of Theft in the Second Degree for a welfare fraud case, and one count of Unlawful Use of Drug and one count of Promoting a Dangerous Drug in the Third Degree in a separate case. Defendant failed to meet general and special conditions of her probation including failing to report to her probation officer on several occasions, failing to do community service or make restitution, and testing positive for drugs. Judge Town revoked her probation and sentenced her to an indeterminate term of 5 years of incarceration for both cases, to be served concurrently.
