STATE ID CARDS AT HALE OLA HO'OKAPOLEA

HONOLULU - Attorney General Mark Bennett announced today that, in an effort to provide more convenient service to the public, personnel of the State Identification Office will be at Hale Ola Ho'okapolea in Waianae on Saturday, March 19, 2005, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 pm, to process applications for State ID cards. The address is 89-137 Nanakuli Avenue.

First priority will be given to individuals with completed applications and required certified documents. Applicants may obtain application forms on-site.
