STATE EXTENDS DEADLINE FOR HALEIWA FARMERS' MARKET

HONOLULU – Attorney General David Louie and Department of Transportation Director Glenn Okimoto announced today that the State will allow the Haleiwa Farmers' Market (HFM) to remain at its present location for two more weeks, through May 27, 2012, to facilitate its move to a new location.

Attorney General Louie stated, "We are very pleased that we have been able to work cooperatively with HFM to achieve this result. We understand that HFM is very close to finalizing arrangements for its new location, and that some additional time is needed."
