**REPORT ON THE NUMBER OF PEN REGISTER ORDERS
AND ORDERS FOR TRAP AND TRACE DEVICES
APPLIED FOR BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES OF THE STATE**

Section 803-47(c), Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires that “[t]he attorney general, at least twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session, shall annually report to the legislature on the number of pen register orders and orders for trap and trace devices applied for by law enforcement agencies of the State.”

As of December 3, 2007, two pen register orders and orders for trap and trace devices were applied for by law enforcement agencies of the State in 2007.
