

# State of Hawaii Semi-Annual Crime Summary

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
*Data derived from arrests and crimes reported to the police can only provide estimates of the actual extent of crime. Shifts in law enforcement focus, isolated cases resulting in multiple arrests, and broader societal changes that affect the likelihood that victims will report certain types of crimes are some of the factors that may affect these data.*

The number of Index Crimes<sup>1</sup> reported in Hawaii during the first six months of 2001 increased 4.8% from the number reported during the same period in 2000. The number of reported violent crimes (murder, forcible rape, robbery, and aggravated assault) fell 0.1%, while the number of reported property crimes (burglary, larceny-theft, and motor vehicle theft) rose 5.1%. Nationally, the number of reported Index Crimes decreased 0.3% during the first six months of 2001.


## Distribution of Reported Offenses, First Six Months of 2001

The City & County of Honolulu, Hawaii County, and Maui County each posted increases in total Index Crimes, violent crimes, and property crimes. Maui County recorded the largest overall increase in Index Crimes (16.1%), violent crimes (12.1%), and property crimes (16.3%). Kauai County posted the only decreases, in total Index Crimes (19.7%), violent crimes (44.6%), and property crimes (17.9%).

Juvenile arrests decreased 10.0% and adult arrests fell 4.1% in the first six months in 2001. Both juvenile and adult arrests decreased for violent and property crimes.

The value of property stolen in Hawaii during the first half of 2001 totaled \$30.2 million, up 11.7% from the same period in 2000.
