




What is the age at which someone in the US is most likely to experience homelessness?

Underage1


Followed by ages 1-5

in Hawai'i experience homelessness annually




44% of households

38 available, affordable homes




- Delays in language, literacy, and socioemotional development

Our solution:

A community-driven response to the urgent crisis of child and family homelessness.





Human Trafficking and Homelessness are negative effects of vulnerability, and each causes vulnerability to the other.

reported experiencing homelessness when recruited into trafficking

of survivors reported experiencing homelessness during childhood

reported household incomes under \$25,000 per year

Challenges for survivors with children

- Scarcity of family shelter beds
- Limits on family size and composition
- Lack of family-sized housing units

"[O]ne of the most effective ways to reduce ... risk of falling into human trafficking is to end their homelessness by providing a safe and stable place to stay."














Number of public school students experiencing homelessness






