Attorney General Investigators Execute Search Warrant at the Honolulu International Airport

Investigators from the State of Hawaii Attorney General's Office executed a search warrant at the Honolulu International Airport this morning. The search warrant authorized the search of the offices and work areas belonging to Dennis Hirokawa, Airport Maintenance and Construction Supervisor and Richard Okada, Visitor Information Program Manager. The ongoing criminal investigation is looking into allegations of forgery, conspiracy to commit theft, theft and bribery related to small purchase contracts issued by the maintenance division of the State Department of Transportation, Airports Division. Records recovered by the Attorney General Investigators were related to Fiscal years 1995 to present.
