STATE ID CARDS BEING ISSUED ON DESIGNATED SATURDAYS

Honolulu, Hawaii - State Attorney General Earl I. Anzai announced today that residents of Lanai will be able to obtain State ID cards on Saturday, August 24, 2002. State personnel will be on the Island of Lanai between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. at the Lanai Community Center to provide this on-island service.

Information on applicant requirements is available by calling (808) 587-3111 (recorded message) or via the State website at www.state.hi.us/hcjdc.

First priority will be given to individuals with completed applications and required certified documents. Those individuals may make an appointment through Ms. Leticia Castillo, Governor's Liaison Officer (565-6411). The fee is \$10.00 for senior citizens 65 years and older, and \$15.00 for all others. The State ID cards will be processed and mailed back to the applicant within 5-10 working days.
