FORMER INVESTIGATOR SENTENCED TO 15 DAYS IN JAIL FOR 3 COUNTS OF SEX ASSAULT

Attorney General Earl I. Anzai announced today that on September 27, 2002, First Circuit Court Judge Derrick Chan sentenced Michael K. Blakeley to 15 days incarceration for sexually assaulting two women.

Blakeley, a former investigator for the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, pled no contest to three counts of sexual assault in the fourth degree. He subjected two women to sexual contact without consent. Sexual assault in the fourth degree is a misdemeanor, punishable by up to one year of incarceration. Judge Chan granted Blakeley's motion for a deferred plea and sentenced him to 15 days of jail.
