STATE ID CARDS FOR LANAI

Honolulu, Hawaii - Attorney General Mark J. Bennett announced today that State personnel will be on the Island of Lanai to process applications for State ID cards on Saturday, May 24, 2003, from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., at the Lanai Community Center.

First priority will be given to individuals with completed applications and required certified documents. Applicants may obtain application forms and schedule their appointments by calling Ms. Bernie Ohashi at 565-7878, of the Lanai Driver's License Office, located at the Lanai Gym.

The fee is \$10.00 for senior citizens 65 years and older, and \$15.00 for all others, payable in cash only. The State ID card will be processed and mailed back to the applicant within 5-10 working days.
