CHUN SENTENCED

HONOLULU-Attorney General Mark Bennett announced today that:

First Circuit Court Judge Sandra Simms sentenced Mark K. Chun on October 1, 2003 to four days of incarceration with credit for time served. Chun was granted a deferral period of 5 years for the offense of Theft in the Second Degree. From November 2000 through January 2001, Chun collected \$1,478.00 in unemployment benefits while working for the City and County of Honolulu, Department of Parks and Recreation. He is currently a groundskeeper at Kapiolani Park. The Court also ordered Chun to perform 50 hours of community service work and to pay restitution to the State of Hawaii.

Theft in the Second Degree is a class C felony offense that is punishable by a fine of up to \$10,000.00 and up to 5 years imprisonment. If you know of anyone who is receiving unemployment benefits and not reporting their employment, please call the hotline at 586-8947.
