Extended Hours for State ID Card Applications

(HONOLULU) – The State Identification Card office will extend its hours of operation during a six-month trial period. From January 24, 2008 through July 31, 2008, the office will be open to the public from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm on Thursdays. Applicants must enter the office before 5:30 pm.

On all other business days, the office will be open during its regular hours of 8:00 am to 2:00 pm.
