**ARREST ON MAUNA KEA AFTER OFFICE OF MAUNA KEA MANAGEMENT
RANGER VEHICLE STRUCK BY CAR**

HONOLULU – Early this morning, law enforcement personnel arrested an individual for criminal property damage after she allegedly struck the vehicle of an Office of Mauna Kea Management (“OMKM”) ranger with her own car. The individual allegedly drove up to a ranger and two sheriffs on July 12, 2015 at 2:30 am and argued with them for not allowing her to ascend the mountain. She then advanced her car into the OMKM ranger’s vehicle, causing minor damage. No one was injured.
