MAN CHARGED WITH FELONY THEFT

HONOLULU – Attorney General Doug Chin today announced that a felony theft charge has been filed against William Duseigneur.

Duseigneur is charged with second-degree theft. The charging document against Duseigneur, a 28-year old Waianae resident, alleges that on July 22, 2016, he intentionally obtained or exerted control over the property of Wesley Uehara in an amount exceeding seven hundred fifty dollars, intended to deprive Mr. Uehara of the property knowing that Mr. Uehara had lost or mislaid it, and that Duseigneur failed to take reasonable measures to discover and notify Mr. Uehara of the lost or mislaid property.

Second-degree theft is punishable by up to five years in prison and a \$10,000 fine. Duseigneur is presumed innocent unless and until he is found guilty of the charge beyond a reasonable doubt. A copy of the felony information is attached.

FELONY INFORMATION

On or about the 22nd day of July, 2016, in the City and County of Honolulu, State of Hawaii, WILLIAM F. K. DUSEIGNEUR, did intentionally obtain or exert control over the property of Wesley K. Uehara, the value of which exceeds Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00), that WILLIAM F. K. DUSEIGNEUR knew to have been lost or mislaid, and with the intent to deprive Wesley K. Uehara, the owner of the property, WILLIAM F. K. DUSEIGNEUR did fail to take reasonable measures to discover and notify Wesley K. Uehara, thereby

committing the offense of Theft in the Second Degree, in violation of Sections 708-830(3) and 708-831(1)(b) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes.
