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Overview of the Litigation Deposits Trust Fund

The Litigation Deposits Trust Fund, appropriation number T-909-N, was established pursuant to Act 178, Session Laws of Hawaii 2002, to account for moneys received through any civil action in which the State is a party where the settlement amount is \$100,000 or higher. Pursuant to section 28-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), the trust fund is administered by the Department of the Attorney General, which must annually report to the Legislature (1) the transactions, by subsidiary account, that take place in the fund for each fiscal year, and (2) a summary of the collections made in any amount on behalf of other departments and agencies specifying the appropriate number of transactions and amount collected for each department and agency.

During Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-2020, the following significant transactions occurred in the trust fund:

REVENUES:

The fund received \$143,990.00 as a temporary deposit from the Hawaii State Public Library System to be paid for a fine to the Environmental Protection Agency.

EXPENDITURES:

Services to store electronic documents: \$1,125.00 Paid to Epiq Company related to the tobacco settlement

Cancer Fund: \$2,656,979.50 Distribution of liquidated assets to Rockefeller Philanthropy Advisors, Inc.
