Pursuant to section 803-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes

For Calendar Year 2023

Submitted to the Thirty-Second State Legislature Regular Session of 2024

Section 803-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires each relevant department director and county police department chief to submit an annual report of incidents of unnecessary or excessive force on arrestees that were reported by law enforcement officers to their supervisors during each calendar year.
