**RECIPIENT’S RIGHTS**

You have been served with an investigative subpoena in an administrative investigation, issued by the Attorney General of the State of Hawaii, in accordance with section 28-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to produce certain records and information, and to appear at the time and place specified to give sworn testimony. **Please reach out to the “Contact Person” listed above if the box is checked that you are not required to appear in person for testimony.** Attendance is required only in the county in which the subpoena is served, or such other place as may be agreed upon by you and the issuing authority. If the subpoena is served in a county other than that in which you reside, are employed, or transact business, the Department of the Attorney General shall bear the expense of travel as provided by the rules of the court.

If you disobey this subpoena, the Attorney General may apply to the circuit court in the county in which you reside or are located to compel obedience. Prior to the date on which you are commanded to appear, you may move the circuit court to quash or modify the subpoena if compliance would be unreasonable or oppressive or violate any privilege you may be entitled to exercise in a court proceeding.

## EXHIBIT 1

1. Definitions of all dispatch codes and identifiers used in the Maui Police Department (MPD) Event Chronologies and Dispatch Reports for August 8 through August 10, 2023, as produced by the County of Maui to FSRI on October 16 and 23, 2023, including without limitation those listed in Attachment A hereto.

3. All policies, protocols, guidelines, or methodologies for assigning UDTH event types.

    - Casualty search/body recovery.

8. Any and all records of mandatory and/or recommended educational and training requirements for each MPD position.
9. All records of personnel deployment assignments, i.e., performance in a trainee role during an emergency incident in another jurisdiction (e.g., Hawai'i Island, California, etc.) for all MPD personnel from 2018 up to and including 2023.
10. All policies and procedures for responding to wildfire or wildland urban interface (WUI) incidents.
11. All evacuation plans and analyses.
12. All After Action Reports (AARs) related to any and all wildfire incidents, WUI incidents, or mass evacuations.
13. The PowerPoint presentation shared by Sgt. Chase Bell during the regular meeting of the Maui Police Commission on September 20, 2023.
