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#### RECIPIENT'S RIGHTS

You have been served with an investigative subpoena in an administrative investigation, issued by the Attorney General of the State of Hawaii, in accordance with section 28-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to produce certain records and information, and to appear at the time and place specified to give sworn testimony. Please reach out to the "Contact Person" listed above if the box is checked that you are not required to appear in person for testimony. Attendance is required only in the county in which the subpoena is served, or such other place as may be agreed upon by you and the issuing authority. If the subpoena is served in a county other than that in which you reside, are employed, or transact business, the Department of the Attorney General shall bear the expense of travel as provided by the rules of the court.

If you disobey this subpoena, the Attorney General may apply to the circuit court in the county in which you reside or are located to compel obedience. Prior to the date on which you are commanded to appear, you may move the circuit court to quash or modify the subpoena if compliance would be unreasonable or oppressive or violate any privilege you may be entitled to exercise in a court proceeding.

## EXHIBIT 1

For any and all positively identified victims of the Lahaina wildfire:

- Records documenting the last known residential address of each decedent.
- Records documenting the location that the remains of each decedent were recovered (e.g., inside structure, outdoors, inside vehicle, etc.), including all documents used to prepare Chart 3 on page 65 of the MPD Preliminary After-Action Report, "Maui Wildfires of August 8, 2023."
- Records documenting the cause of death of each decedent, where known.
