Dear Agency Head:

The Hawaii Law Enforcement Standards Board is conducting an internal review of proposed administrative rules governing law enforcement officer certification, training, and professional standards. As part of this process, Permitted Interaction Groups (PIGs) are reviewing how the proposed rules align with existing statutory and policy frameworks across state and county agencies.

At the Board's January 15, 2026 meeting, Chair Adrian Dhakhwa directed the Administrator to request information from all law enforcement agencies to support PIG review of draft administrative rules covering law enforcement training standards, professional conduct standards, and related topics.

The enclosed attachments detail the specific information requested to assist three separate Permitted Interaction Groups:

**Attachment A: Requests for PIG Group A (Chapters 1, 2, and 9)**

**Attachment B: Requests for PIG Group B (Chapters 3, 4, and 5)**

**Attachment C: Requests for PIG Group C (Chapters 6 and 8)**

This request is limited to documents currently in effect and does not seek analysis, interpretation, recommendations, feedback, or evaluative commentary of any kind. Please note that some agencies may have previously provided portions of this information in response to the Board's December 22, 2025 request for **PIG Group D** (Chapter 7 – Certification Action Procedures). If information requested in the enclosed attachments has already been submitted in response to the Group D request, agencies need not resubmit that information.

Where the same document is requested for multiple PIG groups in the enclosed attachments, agencies need only submit one copy of that document and may note in their response which requests that document satisfies. The cross-reference column in each attachment identifies information that may be requested by more than one PIG group.

Requested records may be submitted electronically by email to [victor.r.mccraw@hawaii.gov](mailto:victor.r.mccraw@hawaii.gov). If another submission method is necessary due to file size, security, or system limitations, please contact the Board in advance to coordinate delivery.

If any of the requested records raise confidentiality concerns under chapter 92F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, or other applicable law, please identify those concerns so appropriate handling safeguards may be applied.

The documents requested are existing government records. While the Board will make every reasonable effort to maintain confidentiality during the work of the PIGs, the Board cannot guarantee confidentiality if a valid Uniform Information Practices Act request is received. Any disclosure determination will be made in accordance with applicable law.

Please submit the requested materials by Friday, February 13, 2026, if practicable. The Board recognizes that gathering and submitting this information may take additional time, and we appreciate the effort required in assisting the Board with this important work.
